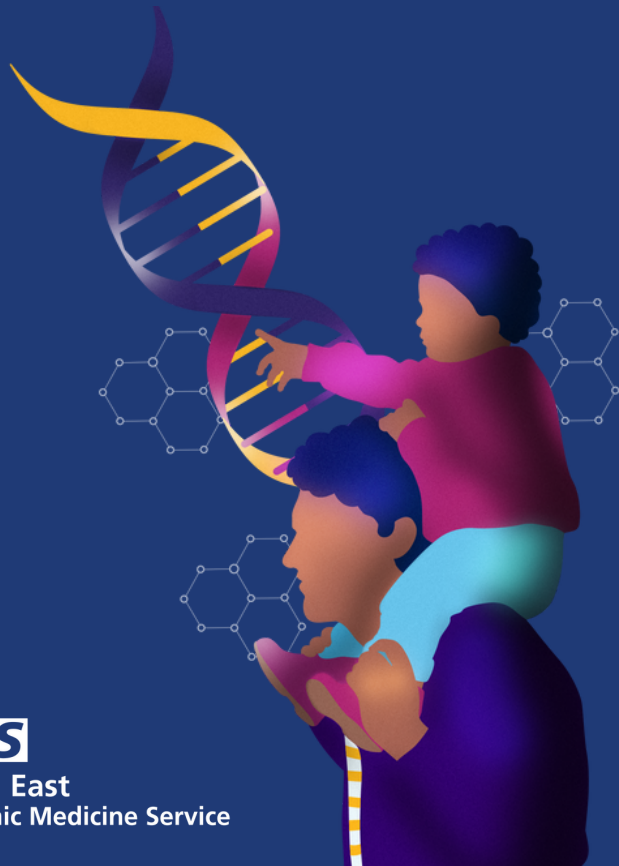

Genetic Testing: Tips & Tricks



Tips for WGS Success

Arrange a trio for paediatric cases to help actionable results.

Store the patient sample correctly (eg blood samples in purple top EDTA).

Complete all forms electronically.
Handwritten will be rejected.

Include the patient's ethnicity to improve accuracy of results.

Explain why the patient meets National Genomic Test Directory eligibility criteria & include ALL HPO terms (Human Phenotype Ontology).

Email the Record of Discussion & Test Order Form to gstt.wgs@nhs.net

Look out for an email from the WGS team. We'll email you if there is a problem.
