Arrange a trio for paediatric cases to help actionable results.

Genetic Testing: Tips & Tricks

Store the patient sample correctly (eg blood samples in purple top EDTA).

Complete all forms electronically. Handwritten will be rejected.

Include the patient's ethnicity to improve accuracy of results.

Explain why the patient meets National Genomic Test Directory eligibility criteria & include ALL HPO terms (Human Phenotype Ontology.
